

## **About this Policy:**

This policy explains when and why we collect personal information about our members, how we use it and how we keep it secure and your rights in relation to it.

We will always comply with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). Further details on GDPR can be found at:

For the purposes of the GDPR, the Membership Secretary will be the “controller” of all personal data we hold about you.

We collect Member's name, address, telephone number, e-mail address(es), name of boat etc for the purpose of managing membership and legitimate interests in operating the Club.

## **Consent:**

Member's may withdraw their consent at any time by contacting us by e-mail or letter, but this will mean that membership of RABC may be terminated at the discretion of the committee.

## **How we protect your personal data?**

We have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect personal data from loss, misuse, or unauthorised alteration or destruction. Please note however that where you are transmitting information to us over the internet this can never be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

We will not share your personal data with any third parties, except where we are required to do so by law.

## **How long do we keep your information?**

We will hold your personal data on our systems for as long as you are a member of the Club and for as long afterwards as it is in the Clubs' legitimate interest to do so.

## **Your rights**

You have rights under the GDPR: (a) to access your personal data (b) to be provided with information about how your personal data is processed (c) to have your personal data corrected (d) to have your personal data erased in certain circumstances (e) to object to or restrict how your personal data is processed
